The Watson Players encourage a safe, supportive, professional, creative and friendly environment for our members. We rely upon your co-operation and agreement to suitable standards of conduct. The Watson Players asks for your full commitment to rehearsal schedules. It is not acceptable to be absent from a rehearsal without a valid reason. We ask that you report any known absences to the Production team, giving as much notice as possible. This will include holiday vacations. If you are unwell please contact the Production team to pass on your apologies.

- The Watson Players asks that you treat all property, equipment, props, costumes and scripts with care. Wilful damage or theft of property belonging to the Society or fellow members will not be tolerated and will be treated as a criminal act.
- We will not tolerate fighting or disorderly conduct.
- You are asked to listen to and follow the reasonable instructions of the Production Team and Technical Crew, with particular attention to Health & Safety both at rehearsals and the performance venue.
- You are asked to follow polite etiquette during rehearsals and at the performance venue. Listen to the instructions of the Production team and do not talk over them.
- You cannot carry out Watson Players activities whilst intoxicated or under the influence of any drug. You may not bring or drink alcoholic beverages at rehearsals.
- You may not promise the services of The Watson Players or use its branding without the express permission of the Society Officials.

We ask that our members adhere to our Code of Conduct. Please sign to indicate your agreement and understanding. Failure to follow the requirements of this Code of Conduct may result in cancelled membership.
